Invesco Balanced Risk 10 Fund (UK) (the "Fund") A fund of Invesco Diversified Balanced Risk Investment Series (the "Company") Z Accumulation share class (ISIN: GB00B8N44H95) (the "Share Class")

The Fund is managed by Invesco Fund Managers Limited, part of the Invesco Group.

Objectives and Investment Policy

- The objective of the Fund is to achieve long-term (5 years plus) capital growth.
- The Fund invests in derivatives to gain exposure to three main asset classes: debt, shares of companies and commodities worldwide, although some investments may be made directly.

The Fund balances the risk of each of these asset classes through different economic environments.

- The Fund aims to target 10% average volatility (a measure of the size of short-term changes in the value of an investment) over a full market cycle (5 years plus). However no assurances can be made that this target will be met.
- The reference in the Fund's name to the 10% average volatility target should not be confused with the rating in the Risk and Reward Profile below. The Fund makes significant use of derivatives (complex instruments) for investment purposes and to manage the Fund more efficiently, with the
- aim of reducing risk, reducing costs and/or generating additional capital or income.

 The Fund is actively managed providing exposure to debt securities, shares of companies and commodities, using a risk-balanced approach and is
- not constrained by a benchmark.
- The reference to (UK) in the Fund's name only relates to the Fund's domicile and is unrelated to the Fund's objective and investment policy. You can buy, sell and switch shares in the Fund on any Dealing Day (as defined in the Prospectus).

 Any income from your investment will be reinvested.

Recommendation: The Fund may not be appropriate if you plan to withdraw your money within 5 years.

Other Risks


