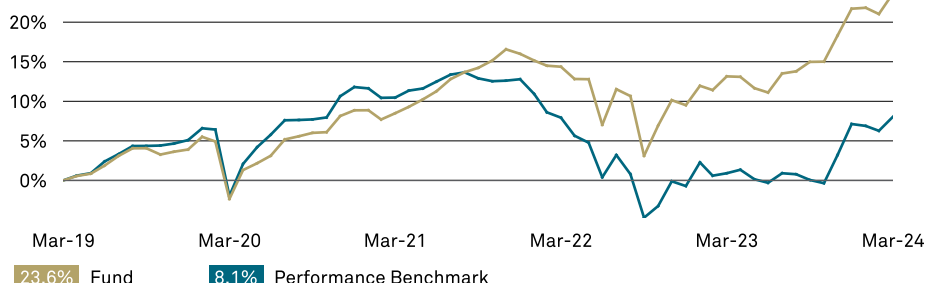

5 YEAR CUMULATIVE PERFORMANCE (%)

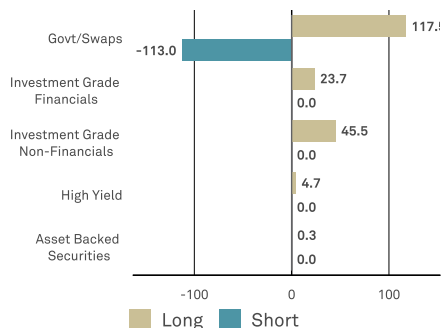

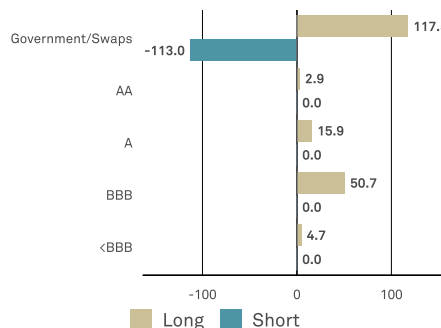

KEY RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH THIS FUND
