The SL HSBC Islamic Global Equity Index Pension Fund invests primarily in the HSBC Islamic Global Equity Index Fund. The aim of the HSBC Islamic Global Equity Index Fund is summarised below.

The HSBC Islamic Global Equity Index Fund (the Fund) aims to create long term appreciation of capital through investment in a diversified portfolio of securities as defined by a relevant world index, which meets Islamic investment principles as interpreted and laid down by the Shariah Committee and provided to the Board of Directors. The Fund tracks the DJ Islamic Market Global Titans 100 Index which is Shariah compliant. The Fund follows an investment process that has been approved by an independent Shariah committee. The Shariah committee monitors the Fund throughout the year and issues an annual Shariah certificate on the Fund's compliance with Shariah principles. This certificate is included in the annual financial report of the Fund as a confirmation of the Shariah compliance for that year.


