The Fund aims to provide long term growth by investing in one or more passively or actively managed equity funds. These funds will invest in a portfolio of equities from around the world and may also utilise factor based strategies.

As the Fund invests in more than one fund the allocation between these funds may vary over time.

These funds may use derivatives for the purpose of efficient portfolio management, reduction of risk or to help funds meet their respective investment objectives if this is permitted and appropriate.

One or more of these funds may have a bias towards a range of investment factors at any one time. Further details on these investment factors and the screening strategies deployed by the funds may be found in the SL underlying fund factsheet.

The Sterling value of overseas assets held in the Fund may rise and fall as a result of exchange rate fluctuations.


